STATEMENT ON LAST NIGHT'S WEATHER CONDITIONS

September 2nd, 2025

Due to extreme weather conditions last night, five of our smaller vessels turned back for safety reasons. We are relieved to confirm that everyone is safe and accounted for, and the mission continues.

When small civilian vessels must do the work that governments have failed to do, sailing to break the siege and end the genocide, challenges like these are common. If even one of the complicit governments sent their far more capable ships to Gaza, these obstacles would not fall on ordinary people.

We remain steadfast in our commitment to reach Gaza, to join with ships departing from Tunis, Greece, and Italy, and to stand united in breaking Israel's illegal siege with a humanitarian and nonviolent mission.
